Public Comments

Action Items All items identified below are for action at the Commission business meeting.

1. T-10.2.PCN (Wayne)

On February 1, 2010 Eric Fruehstorfer dba AAA Night Taxi, Lewistown, Montana filed an application to expand the authority held under PSC No. 9471 and remove the restricted hours of service. Applicant currently holds PSC No. 9471 authorizing the following:

Class B – Passengers between all points and places in Lewistown, Montana and a ten (10) mile radius thereof. LIMITATIONS: 1) Transportation is authorized between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m., only. 2) Transportation in limousine service is prohibited.

If granted, it would amend PSC No. 9471 to read:

Class B – Passengers between all points and places in Lewistown, Montana and a sixty (60) mile radius thereof. LIMITATION: 1) Transportation in limousine service is prohibited.

The application was noticed to the public on March 5, 2010 and no protests were received

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approve the application to broaden PSC No. 9471.

2. T-10.3.ST (Wayne)

On February 25, 2010 Michael A. Murray II dba Green Taxi, Missoula, Montana filed an application to transfer PSC No. 9465 to Green Taxi LLC, Missoula, Montana. The transfer was noticed to the public on March 5, 2010 and no protests were received.

Class B-Passengers between all points and places in Missoula County, Montana. Limitations: (1) Transportation of passengers in limousine service is prohibited; (2) Transportation of non-emergency medical and psychiatric patients to or from medical appointments at health care facilities is prohibited.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approve the transfer of PSC No. 9465.

3. T-10.4.OTSC (Wayne)

On March 11, 2010 an Order to Show Cause was issued to PSC No. 3265, Electric City Transfer and Storage, Inc., Great Falls, Montana for failure to purchase a 2010 vehicle registration receipt as required under

69-12-421 MCA. The Order to Show Cause was received by the motor carrier on March 15, 2010 and no order has been submitted.

Class B - Household goods (as defined by Commission) from Great Falls, and points within a radius of 50 miles in any direction from said city to all points and places in the State of Montana and from all points and places in the State of Montana to Great Falls and points within a radius of 50 miles in any direction from said city.

SUB A Class C - Property, in the City of Great Falls, Montana and to or from points immediately tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding ten (10) miles in any direction from said city. Limitation: Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Cancel PSC No. 3265 for failure to comply with 69-12-421 MCA.
